## **Registration Information:**

*Registration will be done as follows:*

- ❑ Registration begins on February 3<sup>rd</sup>. Resident teams must be at least 60% Lombard Park District residents.
- ❑ Please be ready at the time of registration, to supply the Park District with the captain's and co-captain's names, addresses, home and work phone numbers and where a receipt of payment should be sent. You may pay by Cash, Check, or Credit Card. Checks are to be made payable to the **Lombard Park District** and turned in with your roster.
- ❑ Rosters are due at the first game. Teams can not play without completed roster.
- ❑ The Lombard Park District is not responsible for incorrect information on registration or roster forms. Please inform the Park District of any change in address or phone numbers so you will receive correct information about changes, meetings or make-ups.
- ❑ The season begins March 9th. Each team will be guaranteed 8 games. Top 4 teams qualify for a single elimination tournament, following regular season games.

## Playing Rules

1. Each game will consist of two 20-minute halves. The clock will run continuously except during the last 2 minutes of each half. During these times, the clock will stop on the official's whistle. Exception: In the last 2 minutes, if the difference in the score is 20 points or greater, the clock will run continuously. If at any point, the difference in score becomes less than 20, the "stop clock" rule will be reinstated.
2. A team must start with 5 players. If a team has 5 players and one fouls out, they may continue with 4 players.
3. Game time is forfeit time.
4. The game will start with a jump ball and then alternate possessions will occur.
5. The scorekeeper's book is the official book.
6. During the game, if a player is fouled in the act of shooting, the offensive team will receive 1 point and the ball out of bounds. Free throws will only be shot during the last 2-minutes of the second half or in overtime in the following situations. The 7<sup>th</sup> team foul will result in 1 point and the ball out of bounds or a 1 and 1. The 10<sup>th</sup> foul will result in 2 points or two foul shots.
7. INTENTIONAL FOUL: All intentional fouls will consist of 2 free throws and the ball awarded out of bounds.
8. TECHNICAL FOULS: All technical fouls will consist of an automatic 2 points and the ball awarded out of bounds.
9. Each team receives 3 time outs per game and 1 time out in overtime.
10. The overtime period is 3 minutes. The clock will run continuously during the first 2 minutes, except during free throws and will stop on all whistles during the last minute. The second overtime is sudden death, i.e. the first team to score after the jump ball will be declared the winner.
11. Any team using an ineligible player will forfeit that game.
12. Misconduct by any player can result in their ejection from the game and further disciplinary action up to and including expulsion from the league. A referee can stop a game at any time due to misconduct by a team.
13. Any player receiving 2 technical fouls in a game will be ejected from the game and face further disciplinary action up to and including expulsion from the program. Any team receiving 3 technical fouls will forfeit the game. Technical fouls also count as personal fouls.
14. NO DUNKING OR HANGING ON THE RIM IS ALLOWED. A technical foul will be assessed.
15. Playoffs will consist of a single elimination tournament. Seeding will be determined by the regular season standings.
16. Ties in league play will be broken by head to head records of teams involved. If still tied, head to head points differential will determine the winner, followed by points scored in a season. If still tied, then a coin toss will determine the winner.
17. NO LOCKER ROOMS ARE AVAILABLE. Come dressed to play.

\*After in house rules, I.H.S.A. rules apply.

## **General Rules**

1. Teams forfeiting twice will be dismissed from the league with no refund of fees.
2. Completed rosters and waivers are due by the first game. A player can be replaced for medical reasons if a doctor's note is given. No other addition can be made during the season.
3. Rosters are limited to 12 players.
4. Team members must wear the same colored jerseys, with a number on it. A technical foul will be assessed to each player without a numbered or matching shirt.
5. All referees decisions will be considered final. No protests will be allowed, except for eligibility questions.
6. The Lombard Park District and/or School District #44 does not assume responsibility for any type of injury or loss of property.
7. The Lombard Park District and/or league supervisor reserves the right to change team names or refuse entry of any player, sponsor, spectator or team if in our opinion it is contrary to Park District ordinances, rules or philosophies.

### **Ejection from a game:**

Any player who is ejected from a basketball game for any reason will receive an automatic one game suspension. This suspension will be served during the team's next league game. Any player ejected from a game must leave the bench and the gym area in a prompt manner. If they do not, they will face further disciplinary action up to and including removal from the league.

### **Illegal Players:**

The use of an illegal player is prohibited. It is grounds for an immediate forfeit. If a team should request identification of a player, that player must provide a picture I.D. to the League Supervisor or the Official. Any team who uses an illegal player puts themselves in jeopardy of being expelled from the league.

### **Liability Statement:**

The Lombard Park District and/or School District 44 does not assume responsibility for any personal injury or loss that any team member or spectator may incur as a result of this program.

# **Behavior Management:**

All participants and spectators are expected to adhere to the Lombard Park District rules and philosophies as well as local, state and federal statutes at all times. Any individual who violates these rules will be subject to disciplinary action up to and including removal from the program.

Any individual who has been administered a disciplinary action has the right to an appeal. This appeal must be in writing and received within 24 hours of the disciplinary action. The Park District will review this appeal in a timely fashion and all disciplinary action will stay in effect while the appeal is reviewed.

### **Forfeits:**

Teams who do not forfeit during the season will receive \$25 at the end of the season.

### **Teams who do forfeit:**

1<sup>st</sup> Forfeit: Team loses refundable forfeit fee.

2<sup>nd</sup> Forfeit: Team must pay \$25 cash before next game.

3<sup>rd</sup> Forfeit: Team will be dropped from league without a refund.

### **Alcoholic Beverages:**

No alcoholic beverages are allowed. If any member of a team or the team's fans are seen consuming alcohol on school or Park property before, during or after their game, they risk forfeiture and disciplinary action up to and including removal from the league. Teams are responsible for their fans. It is up to the team to inform their fans of this policy.

### **Unsportsmanlike Conduct:**

Any team or individual exhibiting unsportsmanlike acts towards members of another team, an umpire, spectators or any Park District representative before, during, or after the game, risks disciplinary action. The Park District reserves the right to administer disciplinary action including suspension, forfeit or expulsion if in our opinion any team or individual displays inappropriate behavior. Referee calls are final.
